

Get the most out of your network options by adhering to care coordination rules.



1 Nominate a GP on the GEMS Network. Your and your dependent(s) can each nominate one GP to take care of all your healthcare needs.

3 Hospital Visits. From time to time, we all may have to go to the hospital. As Tanzanite One and EVO members, your family must use a hospital on the GEMS network. There are a number of network hospitals to choose from (you can find the full list on the GEMS website at www.gems.gov.za). If you don't have a GEMS Network hospital within 50km of your place of residence in an emergency, don't stress. You can still use the nearest hospital.

2 Specialist Visits. If you need specialist care, your GP can refer you to one as part of coordinated care.

4 Authorisations. You won't need a new authorisation from GEMS to keep up with chronic treatments you're on already.

5 Getting more for less. Members on Tanzanite One have access to a network of private hospitals, GP visits and Specialist consultations, subject to care coordination rules.
